Impact Point (IP) System

1. For Impact Points

- **J:** Students joined, excluding club members.
- **T:** Total targeted via mail.
- **Q**: Joined students from the related major, excluding club members.
- R: Total strength of that major
- IP: $\frac{I}{T}x\frac{Q}{R}$ for Project Spiral, Chemshala, LaVida, Vasudha and 137 Inverse.
- IP: $\frac{I}{T}$ for IIEC, Lovelace, Qcell, Oasis and Naxatra.

2. Points Earned = Base points x (Base + ((IP x Outreach factor))

- Base 0.5 for all clubs
- IP calculations have already been shown above.
- The outreach factor will be decided by the SSC Council core members, depending on the outreach scale.
- The outreach factor will be scaled between 1-2.
- Clubs can propose a weight while reporting the event, and SCC members will approve or check it based on the scale of the event and the outreach achieved.

• Base points are the points allotted for that category earlier.

Advantage

- Every club ensure that they will be given at least 50% of the Base points.
- Looking at their report, they will be given outreach factor points so that the IP, if it also comes in the range 0.01 to 0.05, can be increased a bit.

Rewards

- A trophy to the club with the highest points for each semester.
- Certificates will be awarded to all the active club members whose clubs rank in the top 3 positions. Data will be collected after the results.
- The top 2 clubs will receive additional budget allocations as follows, to support future events and initiatives:

• 1st Position: ₹4,200

• 2nd Position: ₹2,800

Guidelines

- Planning & Documentation
 - Clubs must submit their semester plans at least one month in advance, clearly outlining proposed activities.
 - For prebooking logistics and timely budget allocation, clubs must email a summary and budget to SCDC, keeping Priyanshu Pradhan and Natasha Sharma in CC.
 - Signed hard copies of notesheets (by club coordinator and faculty advisor) must be submitted to SCDC. Spending on events is not permitted until approval is received.
 - All events must be **science-oriented**, **educational**, and **engaging**.
- Execution & Verification

- Proof of activity completion is mandatory and may include Instagram post links, event photos, and organiser records in a maintained sheet.
- Clubs will be provided with a standard feedback form, which must be shared during every event or talk. Participants must fill it out so SSC Core can evaluate Outreach points and process e-certificates.
- Clubs must collect one or more A4 sheets for attendance, signed in advance by SCDC, and selected SSC members can provide in case the SCDC is unavailable (informed via the designated WhatsApp group).
- o After the event, attendance sheets must be **submitted promptly**.
- o Participants must write their Name, Email, Roll Number, and Batch on the attendance sheet to avoid unauthorised or duplicate entries.

• E-Certificate & Points Policy

- E-certificates will be issued only for events that fall within the pointeligible limits under each category.
 - Example: If a club organises more than the allowed Student Talk
 Series in a semester, only the first eligible one(s) will be counted for points and certificates.
- To increase participation, clubs may offer e-certificates or incentives, but only point-eligible events will be officially recognized.
- Clubs are encouraged to reach out to SSC members for help or clarification at any point.

Leadership & Recognition

- The Active Live Leaderboard will be displayed during the competition phase.
- o SSC will track and review points and resolve discrepancies impartially.
- All club members involved will receive participation certificates, and coordinators will receive leadership certificates after crossing a 700point threshold.
- Negative points will be imposed for unhealthy competition or code of conduct violations, as decided by SCDC, SSC Core, CSA Science Activity, and DoSA.

• Club Management & Communication

- Clubs with core/pre-core systems must update their core teams by December each year.
- o All clubs are expected to **check their official email accounts daily** to ensure smooth and timely communication.
- A WhatsApp group for tech leads will be created to ensure proper coordination, and an invitation email will be shared. All club tech leads must join through that link. Websites must remain updated to reflect current events, contacts, and documentation.
